


### Tier 1 Monument Health Network (Most Coordinated & Lowest Cost of Care)

### Tier 2 Regional Network (Participating Network)

- In addition to Tier 1 providers, you can access a network of **select Western Slope and Front Range providers**. Please note, you may pay more for services received by a Tier 2 provider. Review the benefit grid on the following pages to see how costs may differ between tiers.
- **Emergency care** is always covered as a Tier 1 benefit.
